AB 2210 – It's The Law

Effective January 1, 2007, laws governing private property tows in California have changed significantly. Written authorizations for each tow, private property owner reporting, release notification and civil fines up to 4x the tow bill are just the start. Failure to report a tow from private property within 60 minutes is now a criminal misdemeanor offense.

Up until this point, compliance on the part of storage lots and private property owners, has not been uniformly enforced; this is change as citizens become more aware of their rights and law enforcement receives external request to institute comprehensive oversight programs.

Delivering a Unified Approach

Meeting the requirements of AB2210 will be difficult to accomplish without a unified approach. C:LOGIC's dispatch and towing management service streamlines incident reporting, improves operations and oversight, and enables collaboration and information sharing across parties involved in the towing lifecycle via a secure, authoritative data repository.

Key AB2210 Provisions

- Written authorization is required for EACH private property tow
- Private property tows must be reported within 30 minutes to avoid civil fines and 60 minutes to avoid criminal penalties
- Property owners must report the tow authorization within one hour
- Storage lots have 24 hours to report vehicle releases or face civil and criminal penalties
